

Enlisted Collar Insignia, 1903-1905

On the last day of 1902 the army brought out new uniforms and with them, collar insignia. A collection of collar insignia for dress uniforms, 1903-1905, is shown in the upper section of the photograph. Collar insignia for service uniforms for this same period are in the lower portion.

Soldiers complained that the insignia were too tall and poked them in the neck. As a result the army reduced the size on most of the collar insignia starting in late December 1904.
