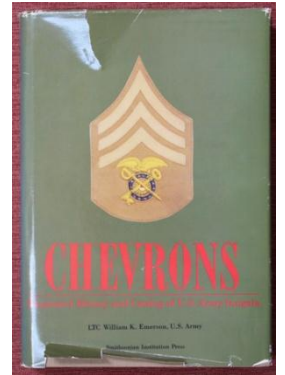

Jewish chaplain's stole. Still has the DSA tag showing the stock number and nomenclature "Scarf, Chaplain Jewish Faith." Two sections near the edge have marks showing rust where it was next to metal. The most noticeable is shown to the left of the national eagle and the second is not as large in another location. \$70.

Clean copy of *Chevrons*, published by the Smithsonian Intuition in 1983. Includes photos and tables showing all U.S. Army chevrons authorized until the book was published. Inscribed by the author in the front but otherwise in good condition, save for a few tears on the top and bottom of the dust jacket. \$100.
