Made in Germany about 1950 tab with silver edge and wording. \$20 including shipping within US. Insurance extra.

Beret flash worn by 11<sup>th</sup> ACR in Germany, 1976-1980. This plastic insignia with imbedded distinctive insignia of the 11<sup>th</sup> Cav was the most commonly worn "flash" as the construction style prevented the cloth flash from becoming soiled. Made in Germany and has the two original plastic German clutches. \$25 including shipping within US. Insurance extra.



Spanish American War Corps badges: First and Seventh Corps Headquarters. These are original, not the recently made fake badges. First Corps back barked "STERLING." Seventh Corps back marked "C.M. Robbins/Maker/Attleboro Mass/USA." \$150 each including shipping within US. Insurance extra.
