Health and Human Services, 2000-present



In 2000 AR 670-1 announced for the first time that army personnel could wear the identification badge for the Office of the Secretary of Health and Human Services. The 2002 edition of AR 670-1 called out the wearing of the badge temporarily upon assignment to the HHS secretary's office and allowed permanent wear after one year. Badges come in a large size for wear on the right coat and in a small version for wear on a right shirt pocket.
